

List of plant species in the Mini Arboretum »Eco-Oasis«

Total number of plants in the Mini Arboretum »Eco-Oasis« is 953 examples of more than 330 species, planted in 4 locations marked as follows:

A - Front garden near the entrance,

B - Conservatory,

C - Main garden area - Atrium,

D - Conifer hedge, fence climbers and roof plants (see also *Map of the Eco-Oasis, Pdf*).

By the finalization of the conservatory the Mini Arboretum will contain in total close to 1000 examples of 350 plant species, varieties and cultivars, including approximately 180 examples of 120 varieties and cultivars of sensible exotic and ornamental plants.

The list of plants comprises botanical plant classification (bi-nominal *Linneus* nomenclature with double Latin names), and names of varieties and cultivars, English common names, origin of species, location of each plant in the Eco-Oasis as well as number of examples. Part of the list is also *Map of the Eco-Oasis (Pdf)* (M=1:100).

Plant species in the list are grouped in **6 main categories**:

1. Coniferous Trees & Shrubs

2. Evergreen Foliage Trees & Shrubs

3. Deciduous Foliage Trees & Shrubs

4. Ferns, Grasses & Ground Covering Plants

5. Perennials & Herbs

6. Exotic & Ornamental Plants

7. Climbers
